DEFINITIONS (as used in this form)

Hurricane Area

means being between 12 degrees 40 minutes North and 23 degrees 30 minutes North by 55 degrees West and 87 degrees West (the "BOX")

Guardianage Service

means you have entered into a contract with a person or organisation who will conduct regular checks of your boat whilst you are away from your boat for more than 7 days and in the event of a hurricane warning have a written hurricane contingency plan.

Hurricane Period

means the period 1 July to 1 November, both dates inclusive
